

On the fast track to more parking



A Dominion Construction crane lifts a huge section of the new campus parkade being built on the former parking lot Z, south of College Drive next to Griffiths Stadium. The \$14.2-million project was approved by the Board of Governors last fall. The five-storey structure, which will provide parking for 866 vehicles for residence and other students, visitors to the new Physical Activity Complex (PAC) and others, is rising rapidly as the pre-cast concrete pieces are hoisted into place. Project manager David Humphries says it is on-schedule, with a target of being open for the start of classes this September.
